That was until the Royal Society of Arts developed the Fourth Plinth Project to celebrate all walks of modern life. In 1998 it commissioned three works for the Fourth Plinth. "The reconstruction of the lamassu set on the Fourth Plinth allows an apparition to haunt Trafalgar Square at a time when we are witnessing a massive migration of people fleeing Iraq and Syria.

What's on the Fourth Plinth now | London City Hall For the Fourth Plinth, Rakowitz has recreated the Lamassu. This winged bull and protective deity guarded the entrance to Nergal Gate of Nineveh (near modern day Mosul) from c700 BC until it was destroyed by Daesh in 2015.
